Deuteronomy 4.1-2, 6-8; Psalm 14; James 1.17-18, 21-22,27 Mark 7.1-8, 14-15,22-23.

Whilst my faith might be something very personal and individual, the faith is something I should always approach with humility. It is not something I own or can invent. It is always received, and needs to be received with wisdom and understanding. Moses calls on the people to follow God's law because that will give them life. James insists that his hearers are to accept and submit to the word that is planted so that they may "save their souls". Jesus called the people to himself that they might "listen and understand". There is no substitute for careful reflection and pondering if we are to enable the word to enter and transform our lives. This is about allowing the word to give us life.
