

100 CLUB RULES

1. The 100 Club is a private lottery and is open to all St Helen's and St Margaret's Parishioners over the age of 16 years.
2. The object of the 100 Club is to raise Parish funds.
3. The 100 Club will be administered by nominated PCC members.
4. Participants, known as Members, must fill in an Application Form.
5. Entry to monthly draws will be by subscription only and tickets will be limited to a maximum 150.
6. Tickets are £2 each per draw with a minimum annual subscription of £24.
7. There will be one winner each month.
8. The prize each draw will be 50% of the value of tickets sold up to a maximum £150. The remaining 50% will go into Parish funds.
9. A register will be kept recording the names and contact details of each Member, the number(s) allocated to them and the subscriptions received from them.
10. To assist with administration, we would prefer you to pay annually by Standing Order but understand if this is not possible.
11. Payment should reach us by the 7th of the month if paying by cheque and the 15th of the month if paying by Standing Order or cash to ensure inclusion in that months' draw.
12. Members may purchase more than one ticket (subject to availability).
13. Additional new Members will be entered for the draw in the calendar month that follows receipt of the first monthly payment.
14. Each draw will take place on the last Sunday of the month at St Margaret's after the 10.30am Mass.
15. Winners will be advised by a 100 Club Administrator personally and all reasonable effort will be made to pay or post prizes to the winners within two weeks of each draw.
16. Winning Members names and winning numbers will appear in the Parish newsletter and on the Parish website the week following the draw.
17. A Member will be deemed to have left the 100 Club if his/her subscription remains unpaid for a period of one month.
18. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into Parish funds after 6 months.
19. The decision of 100 Club administrators shall be final in all matters requiring adjudication.
20. The PPC shall have the power to amend or revoke these rules at their absolute discretion by giving Members one months' notice.
